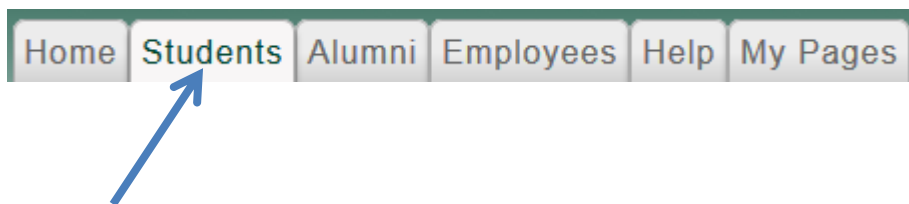


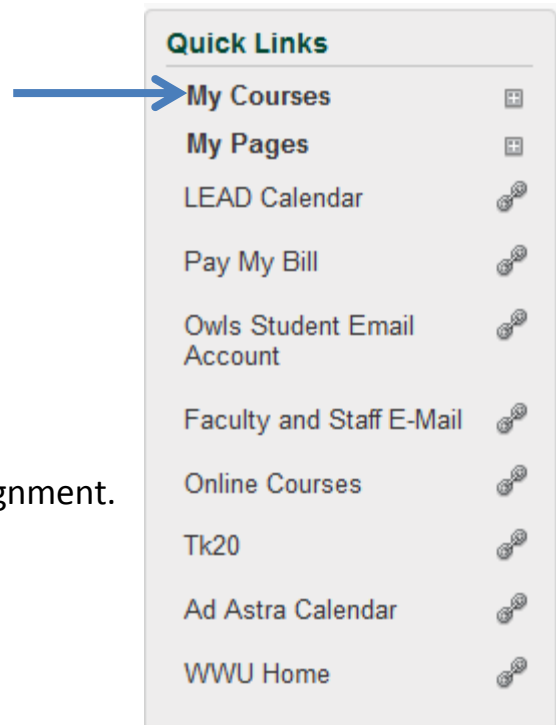

Step 1: Log in to your OwlNet Account

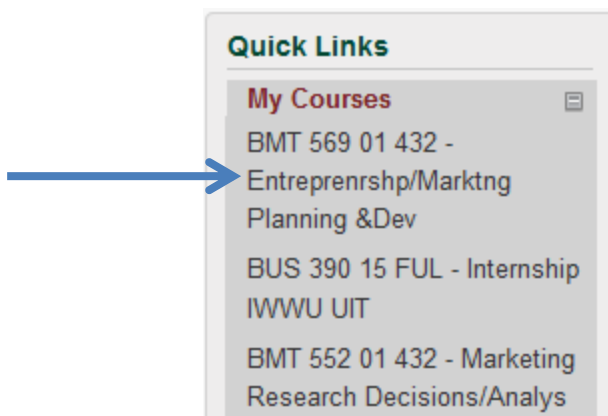
Step 2: Click on the **Students** Tab



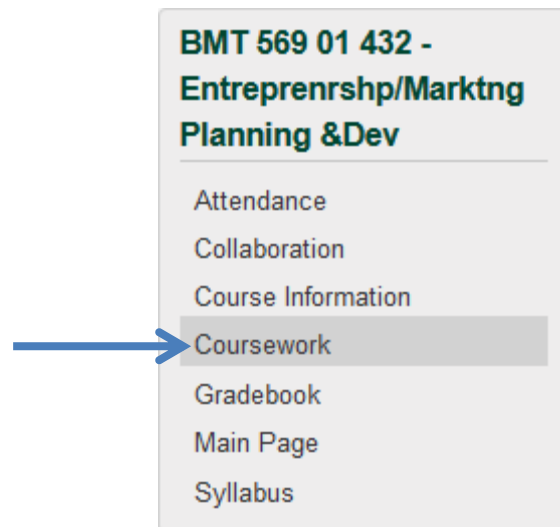
Step 3: On the right side of your screen you will see the **Quick Links** section. Click **My Course** option.
